We employ a wide range of techniques, including cell signaling studies, gene expression profiling, diverse cellular immune assays, and a skin-humanized mouse model to study how dendritic cell signaling regulates the induction of skin inflammation.

## Qualifications

The applicant should hold experience in immunology and cell biology. He/She is required to hold an MD or a PhD in biology, molecular biology, or a related field, as well as strong written and oral communication skills. The working language is English; knowledge of the German language is not necessary.
