	Certified copy of School Leaving Certificate (Higher education entry qualification)
	Research exposé (optional)
	Academic letter/s of recommendation from your university  Must include official letterhead, signature and
_	office stamp and be of recent date
	Professional letter/s of recommendation from your employer
	Must include official letterhead, signature and office stamp and be of recent date
	Verification of work experience (1 year)
	Confirmation of employment
	Declaration of Financial Responsibility (if self-financing, otherwise include your scholarship application or confirmation)
