CONSULTANCY SKILLS IN INTERNATIONAL HEALTH: EVALUATION OF HEALTH FACILITIES, PROJECTS AND PROGRAMMES

Content Overview

This course provides practical knowledge and experience in the evaluation of programmes and projects with a focus on low- and middle-income countries.

Participants strengthen essential consultancy and evaluation skills in international health cooperation through writing an individual consultancy career plan; and in teams using evaluation implementation and planning exercises and case studies.

The course includes sessions on effective writing techniques, how to design and provide effective feedback to different stakeholders and cultural and ethical aspects of evaluation.

Main Topics

- Evaluation and consultancy concepts and skills
- Quantitative and qualitative methods
- Planning a consultancy career
- Current trends in global health relevant to evaluation
- Providing effective written and oral feedback

Target Group

Global health consultants, public health professionals, project and programme planners and managers, facility and service managers, tropEd students, Ministries of Health, development partners.

Prerequisites

This course is held in English. Excellent command/ high level of proficiency in reading, writing and speaking English is required. Experience in writing evaluation reports is desirable.

Learning Objectives

By the end of this course participants will be able to:

- Identify, adapt and use principles, processes and tools for evaluation of health facilities, projects and programmes
- Use key consultancy tools and mechanisms
- Apply the principles of effective writing in evaluations
- Use team building and team management skills
- Analyse personal skills to develop a consultancy career plan

Teaching and Assessment

This course uses lectures (20 hrs), case studies (10 hrs), evaluation reports and tools (30 hrs), discussions with international consultants (4 hrs), individual and group exercises and plenary discussions (11 hrs) and individual study time (15 hrs). Each session has specific objectives and one short key reading. Course participants should bring their own laptop.

Participants are expected to attend teaching sessions full-time and participate regularly in discussions and group work.

Participants will be assessed on:

- Group presentation of an evaluation exercise (40%)
- Individual consultancy plan exercise (60%)

The short courses programme offered by the Heidelberg Institute of Global Health at Heidelberg University provides opportunities for continuing education and professional development. Short courses are open to the Institute's postgraduate students, students from other tropEd member institutions and health professionals wanting to specialise or expand their knowledge in a particular subject area in international health.
