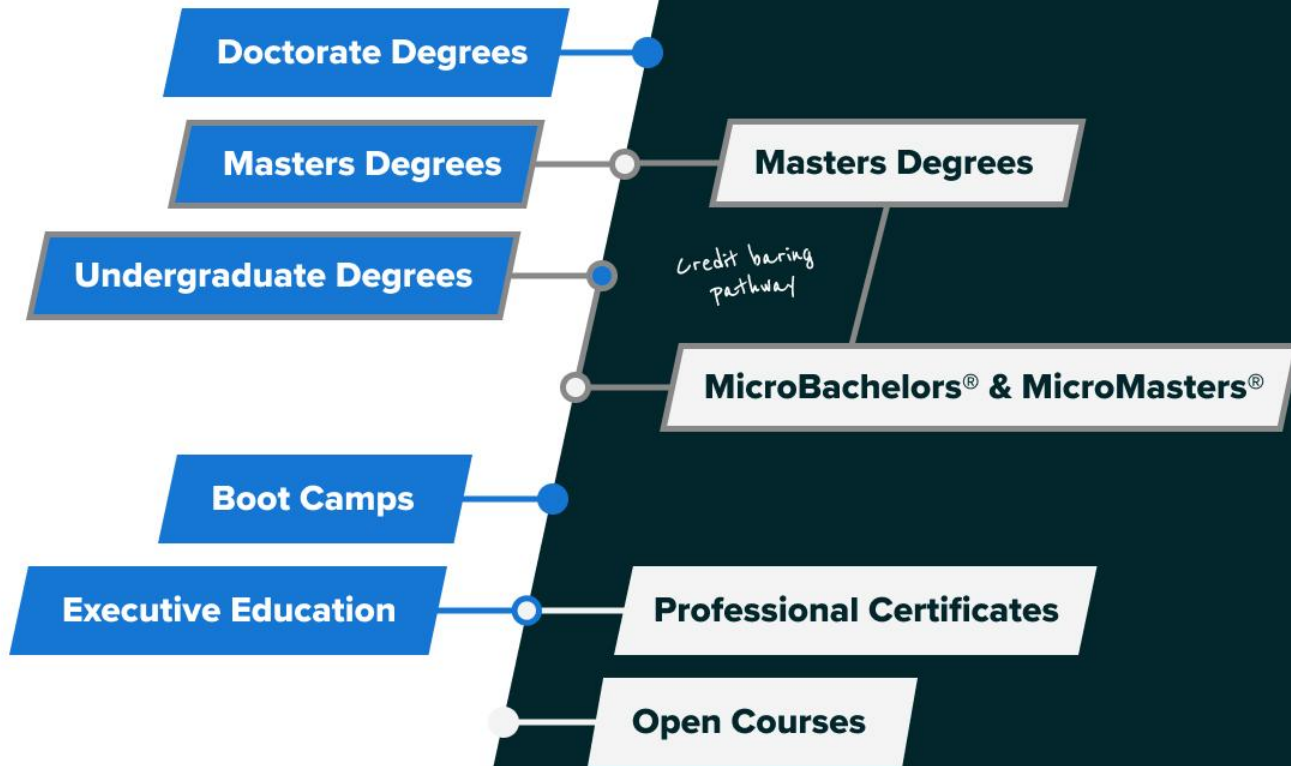

Online learning as a resiliency strategy for campus students

- Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine began using the Open edX platform to **deliver education nationally at the start of COVID**
- Now continuing to **leverage the platform for virtual learning** in the midst of the Russian conflict
- edX is also working with the Ministry and **offering all Ukrainian colleges and universities free access** to edX Online Campus

4. Mapping learning to career-relevancy

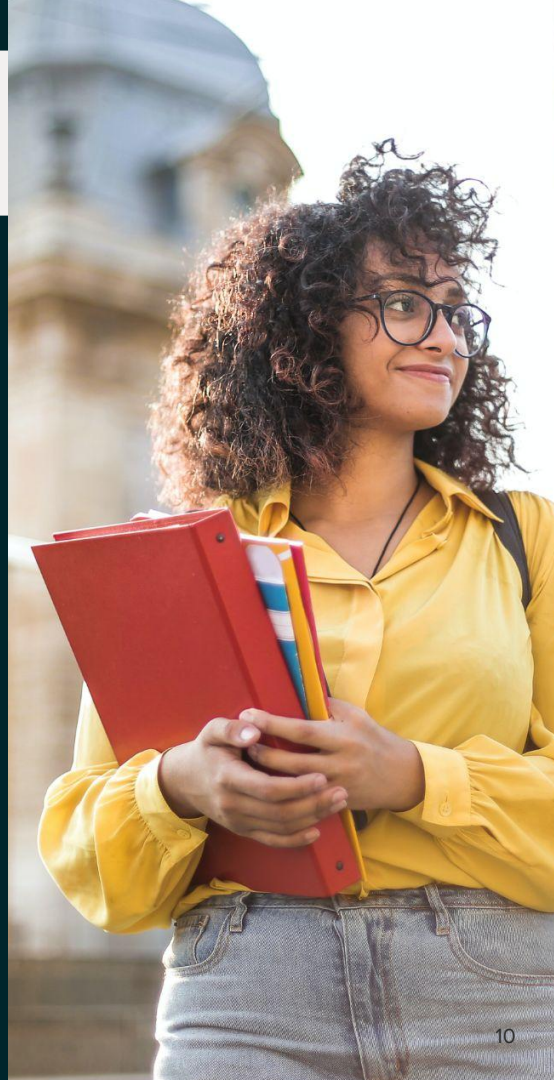


Growth of modular, stackable learning.

68%

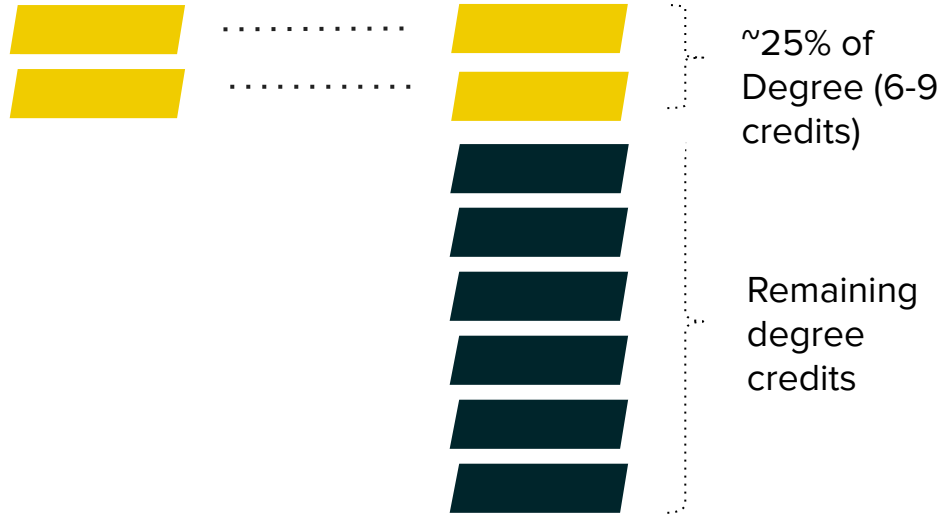
prefer non-degree programs—compared to 50 percent who preferred them before the pandemic.*

MicroMasters® Program

Full Graduate Degree (credit pathways at multiple institutions)



What's a MicroMasters® program?

- Bundle of graduate-level courses that provide deep learning in a specific career field (equiv. to ~25% of degree).
- Serves as an alternative pathway for degree applicants or a standalone credential for career advancement.
- **Over 6MM** unique learners enrolled in a MicroMasters program.

Case Study

Cambridge brings humanities expertise to a global audience.

- University wanted to provide open, flexible and affordable access to high-quality courses for adults from all backgrounds
- MicroMasters® program in Writing served as a pilot to show that **online, modular education works, and quality is preserved**
- Credit pathway into Master of Studies (MSt) in Writing for Performance upon admission into Cambridge
- **140+** countries are represented by learners enrolled in the Cambridge MicroMasters® program.

“This new pathway has led to a subset of the students progressing to our Master’s in Writing for Performance, and **thousands more to continue their learning in other ways.**”

MEF flips on-campus experience.

- MEF, Istanbul, is **one of the first universities in the world to use 100% hybrid/blended learning** across their entire campus.
- edX Online Campus enables the university's digital curriculum.
- MEF is now exploring ways to go even more online and granting university credit for edX courses.

“MEF University uses edX courses to flip its lessons as well as **giving its students the opportunity to select their own learning paths** for an asynchronous elective course called Personalized Learning Experience.”

University of Birmingham creates **local talent pipeline.**

- Boot Camps designed to meet skill needs based on industry input, e.g. Coding and Data Analytics.
- The Employer Advisory Board engages the business community in mentorship and recruitment.
- Scholarship programs for women and people of color increase representation in tech on a large scale.
